- ___ The **bassoon** plays the lowest notes in the woodwinds family and has finger holes, metal keys, and thumb keys
- ___ A **flute** player blows both across and into this instrument.
- ___ **Clarinet** means small trumpet and has a single reed.
- ___ The **saxophone** is made out of brass but makes sounds using a reed.
